

#### **WEEK OF JAN 5**

Second Sunday of Christmas The lectionary continues the medieval idea that Christmas lasts twelve days, and so in some years there are two Sundays of the Christmas season before Epiphany. These twelve days are the appropriate times for Christmas concerts and church parties. Each Sunday can focus on yet another aspect of the mystery of the incarnation. Christmas is not "over"—Christ is born in the hearts of believers each day.

#### **Ephiphany**

Epiphany originally celebrated four different events, in the following order of importance: the Baptism of the Lord; Christ's first miracle, the changing of water into wine at the wedding in Cana; the Nativity of Christ; and the visitation of the Wise Menor Magi. Each of these is a revelation of God to man: At Christ's Baptism, the Holy Spirit descends and the voice of God the Father is heard, declaring that Jesus is His Son; at the wedding in Cana, the miracle reveals Christ's divinity; at the Nativity, the angels bear witness to Christ, and the shepherds, representing the people of Israel, bow down before Him; and at the visitation of the Magi, Christ's divinity is revealed to the Gentilesthe other nations of the earth.
